They depend on what treatment you have, and the length of your stay.

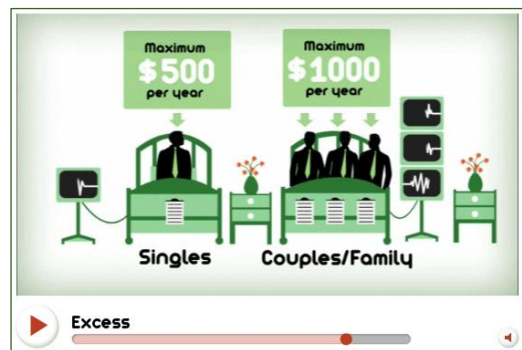
If you have hospital cover, your health insurer will take care of most of these costs.

However there's a small portion that you are responsible for paying, this is called the excess.

With Frank, the most you'll ever pay in a calendar year is \$500 per person or \$1000 per family.

Once you've paid the maximum you won't pay excess again that year, no matter how many times you're sent to hospital.

Fingers crossed, you won't have to pay it at all.
